The online world can be exciting and inspiring. It has lots of opportunities to offer young people. It is important to manage and minimise the associated risks.

Now let's have a think...

In January 2023, the Children's Commissioner published a new document about Young People and pornography.

Within the report some statistics were shared.

In their study, what percentage of children do you think shared that they have seen pornography?

What age do you think these children were?



Here are the alarming results...

- By age 9, 10% of children had seen pornography.
- By age 11, 27% of children had seen pornography.
- Much of what had been viewed was violent.
- Most information that was viewed was not from adult sites but accessed through other online platforms.

Twitter was the main platform children accessed this from, closely followed by Instagram and Snapchat.



Age Appropriate?

The Information Commissioner's Office stated in 2018 that as part of UK GDPR:

- only **children aged 13 years and over** may lawfully provide their own consent for the processing of their personal data;
- an **adult with parental responsibility** must provide consent for processing if the **child is under 13**.

- ★ Discuss images – sexting etc.
- ★ Talk about inappropriate content.
- ★ Family agreement.
- ★ Filtering.

- ★ Lead by example.
- ★ Get involved with their online life.



Reporting

- ★ Check what to do on each device and service.
- ★ Follow up unsatisfactory responses.
- ★ Grooming – CEOP.
- ★ Sexual abusive content – IWF.

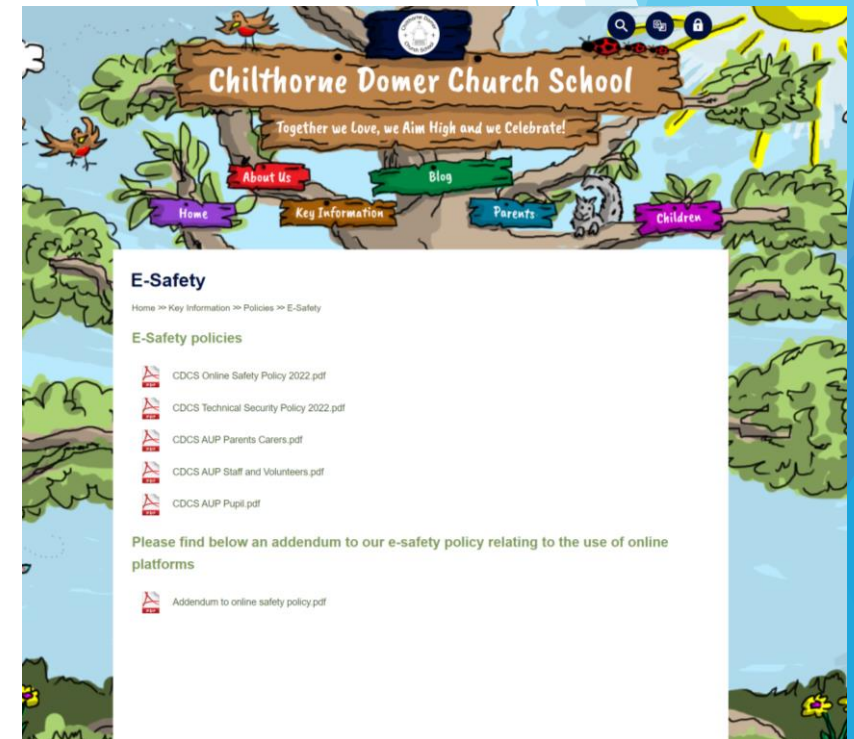
